



How It Works

The concept is simple, the rewards are priceless. Read a book (any book) to your newborn, infant, and/or toddler. The goal is to have read 1,000 books (yes you can repeat books) before your precious one starts 5 year old kindergarten.

Does it sound hard?

Not really if you think about it. If you read just 1 book a night, you will have read about 365 books in a year. That is 730 books in two years and 1,095 books in three years.

If you consider that most children start kindergarten at around 5 years of age, you have more time than you think (so get started). If you are able to, make sure to keep a record of “any” book that is being read to your child. This includes teachers and siblings.

The key is perseverance. Make it exciting. When your child reads 100 books bring him/her into the library and we will give him/her a small reward (from our prize box). When your child has completed their 1000 books they will receive a larger prize and a completion certificate.
